LOCATION: Historic Sauder Village, just northeast of Archbold, Ohio on St. Rt. 2. About one hour west of Toledo and 1 ½ hours east of Ft. Wayne, IN. See enclosed brochure for driving directions

CHECK IN & SET-UP: Wheelmen should come to the Entrance Building of the Historic Village to check in **starting at 8:00 A.M.** on Saturday, August 7. All bikes must be checked in and located on the Village Green by 9:30 A.M. as the Historic Village opens to the public at 10:00 A.M. **All trailers, trucks and cars should be unloaded, moved out of the Historic Village and parked in our parking area by 9:30.** If you need assistance with unloading, please contact Andi Erbskorn at Sauder Village 1-800-590-9755. Those who are only able to attend on Sunday should arrive between 10:30 and 11:30 and be all set up by 11:30 for the 12:00 village opening.

SECURITY: Although all bikes will be displayed within the Village grounds, the responsibility for the security of each bicycle will remain with each registered owner. Ropes will be strung on the shady Village Green for you to tie your bikes on when they are not in use during the day. After the Village closes on Saturday, bikes can be moved inside our Festival Barn until 11:00 PM on Sunday to be ready for the opening at 12:00.

All wheelmen who pre-register will receive complimentary admission into the Historic Village and Doll Show. Also those who are also in costume and ride in the parade will receive a participant ribbon and \$16.00 in Sauder Village Gift Certificates that can be used anywhere in the complex. Ribbons will also be awarded for Machine and Costume judging.

PLEASE NOTE: No pets or smoking are permitted anywhere on our grounds or at the Campground or the Sauder Heritage Inn.
